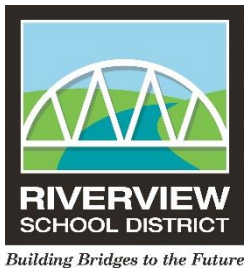

Credit Retrieval
July 5-August 1, 2017**

The Summer School program is an opportunity for high school students to continue working towards academic success and earn credit for courses they did not previously pass.

Students who are currently in grades 9-11, as of June 2017, are eligible to enroll. Courses are offered for credit retrieval in Social Studies, Math, English, and Science. Counselor approval is recommended for high school students who plan to enroll in Summer School.

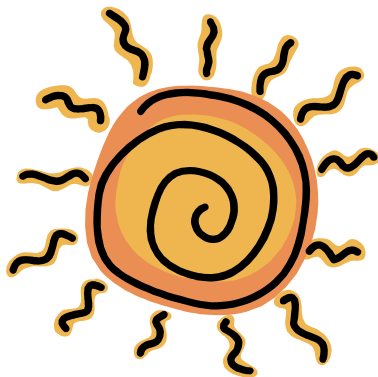

Registration and Tuition

- The completed registration form and tuition payment must be received at the Administrative Offices by June 28. **Registrations will not be accepted after June 28.**
- Students may not attend class unless registration and tuition have been submitted by the deadline.
- Classes will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Students will be enrolled in the requested class(es) unless notified otherwise. No official confirmation will be sent.
- Tuition will not be refunded unless the class is cancelled due to low enrollment.

Fees

- Tuition is \$125 for each .5 credit course.
- Check, or money order or cash will be accepted. Your cancelled check will be your receipt. No confirmation of payment will be sent.

Counselor Approval

Counselor approval is recommended for high school students who plan to enroll in the Summer School program.

More Information

- All Summer School classes will be taught using Riverview School District instructional materials and resources.

- Successful completion of the class will be subject to teacher/instructor assessment of student progress.

Attendance Policy / Behavior

- With the fast pace of the program, full-time attendance is a mandatory component for credit retrieval. **Students are required to attend class daily.**
- Plan vacations around Summer School dates. Make-up work will not be given to students on vacation during Summer School.
- Students who accumulate more than two absences will be withdrawn from the program, will not earn credit, and tuition will not be refunded.
- An absence is defined as missing more than 20 minutes of class time. Punctual attendance is essential.
- Students with excused absences will be allowed to make up the work.
- Summer School students are held to the same standards of conduct as Riverview students are during the school year.

Special Services

- The Summer School program does not have any Special Education classes or support services.
- If your student is on an Individual Education Plan (IEP) or 504 Plan, it is important that you consult with his/her counselor prior to enrolling.

New Students

New students must include a copy of their current Immunization Form.

Transportation

Transportation is not provided. Parents and students are responsible for safe transport to and from Summer School.

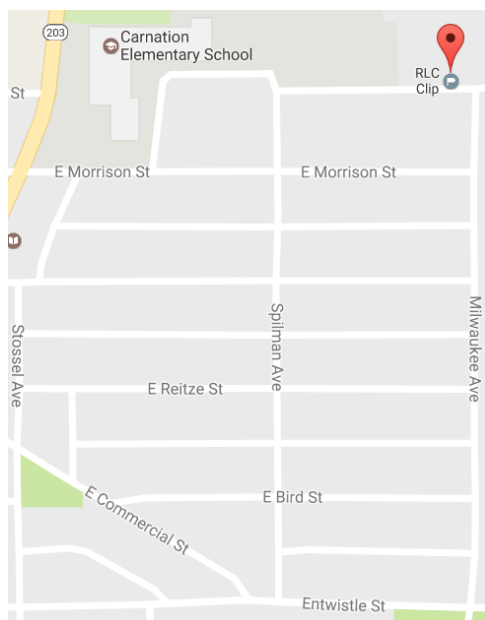
High school courses are available in Social Studies, Math, Science, and English for credit retrieval. Students currently in grades 9-11 (as of June 2017) may register for a maximum of two .5 credit courses. Students are required to attend all class sessions and complete assignments to be eligible for credit retrieval. Actual credit retrieval will be subject to teacher assessment of student progress. Successful students will receive a "Pass" and .5 or 1.0 credit (posted to the student's transcript). No letter grade will be given. Counselor approval is recommended for high school students who plan to enroll in Summer School.

Social Studies Credit Retrieval

Social Studies Credit Retrieval will allow students the opportunity to work individually to earn .5 or 1.0 credit for the Social Studies course in which they were previously enrolled (World History or US History). World History and US History are web-based through the APEX program. Students will be spending 3-6 hours in class depending on assignment completion.

Math Credit Retrieval

Math Credit Retrieval will allow students the opportunity to work individually to earn .5 or 1.0 credit for the Math course in which they were previously enrolled (Pre-Algebra, Algebra I, or Geometry). These courses are web-based through the APEX program. Students will be spending 3-6 hours in class depending on assignment completion.

Science Credit Retrieval

Science Credit Retrieval will allow students the opportunity to work individually to earn .5 or 1.0 credit for the Physical Science course in which they were previously enrolled. This course is an overview of basic science and is web-based through the APEX program. Students will be spending 3-6 hours in class depending on assignment completion.

English Credit Retrieval

English Credit Retrieval will allow students the opportunity to work individually to earn .5 or 1.0 credit for the English course in which they were previously enrolled (Freshman English, Sophomore English, or Junior English). These courses are web-based through the APEX program. Students will be spending 3-6 hours in class depending on assignment completion.
