

RIVERVIEW SCHOOL DISTRICT WEATHER RELATED SCHEDULE CHANGES (COVID-19 PROTOCOLS)

PLEASE NOTE THAT RIVERVIEW SCHOOLS ARE ASSUMED TO BE IN SESSION, UNLESS A MESSAGE IS BROADCAST VIA TEXT, RADIO, TELEVISION, DISTRICT WEBSITE, AND/OR SOCIAL MEDIA

CONDITIONS

Situations involving snow, ice, power outages, windstorms, and floods are continually assessed and may make it necessary to temporarily alter the operation of schools and/or school buses in the Riverview School District.

CHANGES IN SCHOOL OPERATIONS

Changes in school operation schedules may be necessary, resulting in the closure of one or more schools for the day, a late start time, and/or an early dismissal time.

If it becomes necessary to dismiss students early because of inclement weather conditions or a widespread utility outage during the school day, notice of school changes will be distributed to radio stations, television stations, SchoolMessenger text alert subscribers, the District's website, district email (Constant Contact), Skooler LMS, and social media outlets (e.g., Facebook, Instagram, and Twitter).

EMERGENCY OPERATIONS MESSAGING

Messages will be broadcast via Seattle-area radio and television stations, through the Riverview School District website, and Riverview's social media pages on Facebook and Twitter.

SCHOOLMESSENGER TEXT ALERTS

SchoolMessenger Text Alerts are available for families, wanting instant notifications of school delays and closures via a text message sent to their mobile phone.

To receive text alerts from the Riverview School District, you must provide a current mobile phone number in our Skyward student information database.

Once your number is entered in Skyward, a text message, asking you to "Opt-In", will be sent to your mobile phone within 24-48 hours.

Simply reply by texting back the letter "Y", or the word "Yes", and you will be subscribed and begin receiving text alerts when available.

FLASH ALERT

You can also sign up for automatic emails from FlashAlert.net. These emails are tied directly to the school closure and late start media broadcast system.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

If, at any time, you cannot determine what the district's operations plans are, call the Transportation Information Hotline at (425) 844-4542.

Please do not call the schools, the school district office, or radio or television stations for school or bus operations information.

If you are signed up to receive Constant Contact e-mail distributions at your school(s), you may receive further notification updates from your principal.

“GRAB AND GO” MEALS

“Grab and Go” meal service will shift accordingly to the delay of the start of the school day.

CHILDCARE SERVICES | ECEAP PROGRAM
K-12 LIFE SKILLS | PAIVE TRANSITION PROGRAM

Students attending Riverview’s Childcare Program, ECEAP/Preschool Program, or attend the K-12 Life Skills or 18-21 PAIVE Program will have their schedules shift accordingly, with the delay to the start of the school day.

BOOK SUPPLY AND DROP OFF DELIVERIES

In an ongoing Remote Learning model, book supply and drop off deliveries would continue as scheduled. If conditions are deemed as treacherous or too difficult to travel, book supply and drop offs would be cancelled for the day.

MESSAGING

Messages provided by the district will be brief in nature when shared with the public.

“ON-SITE LEARNING CLOSED”

Riverview School District will be closed for On-Site Learning. No On-Site Learning of any kind will take place, and there will be no Out-of-District Transportation. Grab and Go Meals, Childcare, Book/Supply Drops are also cancelled. Virtual meetings, such as IEPs and Committee Meetings, etc., will occur as scheduled.

“TWO-HOUR LATE START”

Riverview School District On-Site Learning and Childcare will begin on a Two-Hour Late Start. Remote Learning will continue as regularly scheduled. Grab and Go Meals will occur Two-Hours Late. There will be no Out-of-District Transportation, Preschool, or Encompass. Book/Supply Drops will be cancelled.

“ONE-HOUR LATE START”

Riverview School District will begin On-Site Learning and Childcare on a One-Hour Late Start. Remote Learning will continue as regularly scheduled. Grab and Go Meals and Book/Supply Drops will occur One-Hour Late. Preschool and Encompass will begin One-Hour Late.

DELAYS INVOLVING “LIMITED BUS TRANSPORTATION”

Limited Bus Transportation Routes (a/k/a Snow Routes) will be implemented in the case of snowfall and/or other emergency occurrences which make it unsafe for buses to pick up students at all regularly identified bus stops. For those students attending on-site learning, Snow Routes will be communicated through collaborative messaging from the Transportation Department, Communications Office, and district office administration.
