The Board discussed the following:

**1. Great News**

- a. School of Distinction: PARADE (ELA/Math Index)
  - i. *PARADE recognized for 3 out of 4 years. This is exciting as student scores are sometimes challenging with varying programs at home and only seeing the students 2-3 times a week for a given class at the secondary level (elementary more frequently).*
- b. Board of Distinction: 4 Years in a row!
  - i. *The superintendent is very proud of our school board and this incredible accomplishment. This would not be possible without having an outstanding team in place. Special thanks to Sandy Bechtel and Dr. Stocker and others that contributed to the application this year. If we get this award for a 5<sup>th</sup> time, we will receive a special award for excellence over time!*

**2. WSSDA Conference**
